Emergency Generators
Application for Approval

This approval is suitable for emergency generators used only for back-up power when the primary electric power is interrupted during emergency situations or for short periods to perform maintenance and operational readiness testing. The KDHE believes that 500 hours is an appropriate default assumption for estimating the number of hours that an emergency generator could be expected to operate under worst-case conditions.

NSPS Subpart IIII applies if construction of the engine commenced (defined as the date the engine was ordered) after July 11, 2005 and the engine was manufactured after April 1, 2006 OR the engine was modified or reconstructed after July 11, 2005.
