


1. From your browser window, click on the "Tools" menu.




2. From the "Tools" menu, click on "Internet Options".



3. From the "Internet Options" window, select the "Security" tab near the top of the window.




4. Within the "Security" tab, click on the "Custom Level" button.




5. Scroll all the way to the bottom of the "Custom Level" menu.

Find the option labeled "Allow websites to prompt for information using scripted windows". (It is usually the third option from the bottom.)


Click the "Enable" circle directly below this option.
