Project Ideas for Diesel Emissions Reduction

For Partnering with KDHE for Diesel Grant Applications to be Submitted to EPA

The Environmental Protection Agency occasionally offers a [national competition for air quality agencies](#). The Bureau of Air in the Kansas Department of Health and Environment partners with a small number of public and/or private diesel fleet owners to submit a grant to EPA. KDHE competes with other states for funds, and the EPA selects the winners.

Are you the owner or operator of a large diesel fleet and have project ideas you would like to implement in your vehicles to reduce diesel emissions and decrease fuel use? If so, you can submit those ideas if you would like to partner with KDHE in applying to the EPA for future competitive grant rounds. If your project fits EPA's criteria it could be selected to be part of the KDHE Bureau of Air grant application. Companies that can contribute funds to the project have a better chance of being selected to participate with KDHE for the grant.
