Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas

Air Quality Construction Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality construction permit. Encana Oil and Gas (USA), Inc. has applied for an air quality construction permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-300. Emissions of nitrogen oxides (NO_x), carbon monoxide (CO), particulate matter (PM/PM₁₀), volatile organic compounds (VOC), sulfur oxides (SO_x), carbon dioxide equivalents (CO_{2e}), and hazardous air pollutants (HAP's) were evaluated during the permit review process.

Encana Oil and Gas (USA), Inc., 5851 Legacy Circle, Plano, TX 75024, owns and operates the stationary source located at SW ¼ of SE ¼ Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, Ness County, Kansas, at which a new oil and natural gas production facility will be constructed. It will consist of two (2) approximately 1000 kW diesel fired generators, one (1) 0.50 MMBtu/hr heater treater, one (1) 68 hp engine, three (3) gunbarrel storage tanks, four (4) stable oil storage tanks, one (1) saltwater purge tank, one (1) diesel storage tank, one (1) elevated flare, and fugitive emissions.

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process are available for public review, from the date of publication, during normal business hours, at the KDHE, Bureau of Air (BOA), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. Also, a copy of the proposed permit only, can be reviewed at the Northwest District Office, 2301 East 13th Street, Hays, KS 67601-2651. To obtain or review the proposed permit and supporting documentation, contact Ashley Eichman, (785) 296-1713, at the central office of the KDHE, and to review the proposed permit only, contact Larissa Parker, (785) 625-5663, at the Northwest District Office. The standard departmental cost will be

assessed for any copies requested.

Please direct written comments or questions regarding the proposed permit to Ashley Eichman, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received no later than the close of business on October 15, 2012.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permit. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Sharon Burrell, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, no later than the close of business on October 15, 2012 in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.
