Calendar Year Enforcement Action Update**

**Enforcement actions result in \$356,250 in penalties 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2010**

<b>Enforcement actions related to the air quality program have been issued to the following Kansas facilities during the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2010</b>	
<b>Larkin Excavating</b> KDHE Consent Agreement and Final Order of the Secretary Issued January 10, 2010	<b><i>\$1,500 civil penalty</i></b>
<b>Kaw Valley Companies</b> KDHE Consent Agreement and Final Order of the Secretary Issued February 2, 2010	<b><i>\$1,500 civil penalty</i></b>
<b>Fuchs Lubricants</b> Final Order of the Secretary Issued February 17, 2010	<b><i>\$48,000 civil penalty</i></b>
<b>Lafarge Midwest</b> EPA/KDH E Consent Decree Issued March 18, 2010	<b><i>55,250 civil penalty</i></b>
<b>Westar Energy</b> EPA/KDH E Consent Decree Issued March 26, 2010	<b><i>250,000 civil penalty</i></b>

An enforcement action typically requires a facility to pay penalties and/or conduct activities to return to compliance with the law. The enforcement action may be issued by the EPA, KDHE, or jointly by KDHE and EPA.

SEP – Supplemental Environmental Projects - As part of a settlement, an alleged violator may voluntarily agree to undertake an environmentally beneficial project related to the violation in exchange for mitigation of the penalty to be paid. An example of a SEP would be a school bus diesel retrofit project.
