Notice of Public Hearing

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is proposing to revise the *State of Kansas Plan for Implementation, Maintenance and Enforcement of the 2008 National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS)* for lead. If requested, a public hearing for this action will be held Tuesday, December 13, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Curtis State Office Building, Flint Hills Conference Room (3rd Floor), 1000 SW Jackson, Topeka, Kansas. If no request for this hearing is received by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 12, then the public hearing will be cancelled and notice of this cancellation shall be posted on the Bureau of Air (BOA) website <http://www.kdheks.gov/bar/publicnotice.html> or phone inquiries may be made to (785) 296-1615.

The State of Kansas Plan for Implementation, Maintenance and Enforcement of National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for lead is proposed in accordance with the requirements of Section 110 of the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments (CAAA) of 1990. Section 110 of the CAAA requires that each state submit to the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) a plan for the implementation, maintenance and enforcement of the NAAQS.

This proposed State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision does not include any rulemaking action.
