

Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas
Air Quality Construction Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality construction permit. DCP Midstream, LP has applied for an air quality construction permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-300. Emissions of particulate matter (PM), PM with an aerodynamic diameter of less than or equal to 10 microns (PM₁₀), volatile organic compounds (VOC), hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), nitrogen oxides (NO_x), oxides of sulfur (SO_x), carbon dioxide equivalent (CO_{2e}), and carbon monoxide (CO) were evaluated during the permit review process.

DCP Midstream, LP, 370 17th Street, Suite 2500, Denver, Colorado 80202, owns and operates the National Helium Gas Plant Complex, which is a natural gas processing and helium production facility. This permit is a modification to the permit issued on March 6, 2012 (C-9880) located at Section 23, T33S, R32W, Seward County, Kansas, at which modifications to the facility will be made for deep ethane extraction and related equipment installation.

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process are available for public review from the date of publication during normal business hours at the KDHE, Bureau of Air (BOA), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366 and at the Southwest District Office (SWDO), 302 West McArtor Road, Dodge City, Kansas 67801. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

Please direct written comments or questions regarding the proposed permit to Lynelle Ladd, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received no later than noon on December 29, 2014.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permit. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Lynelle Ladd, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, no later than noon on December 29, 2014 in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.
