

Notice Concerning Proposed Phase II Acid Rain Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is proposing to issue a five-year permit to the Winfield Municipal Power Plant #2, referred to as East 12th Street in 40 CFR 73 Table 2 (Plant Code: 7013), pursuant to Title IV (Acid Deposition Control) of the Federal Clean Air Act and implementing regulations found in 40 CFR Parts 72 through 78. The effective date of the permit is from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2019.

One (1) utility boiler is affected by this permit action, identified as Unit 4 in 40 CFR Part 73 Table 2 and designated as EU-001 in the facility's Class I operating permit, located at 2801 East 12th Street, Winfield, Kansas 67156 and operated by City of Winfield, P.O. Box 646, Winfield, Kansas 67156, would receive 8 sulfur dioxide (SO₂) allowances for each year from 2015 through 2019. Winfield Municipal Power Plant #2, referred to as East 12th Street in 40 CFR 73 Table 2, proposes to comply with the Acid Rain Program emission requirements by holding enough allowances to cover all sulfur dioxide emissions.

Issuance of this permit would not affect the responsibility of Winfield Municipal Power Plant #2 to meet all other existing local, state, and federal sulfur dioxide emission requirements.

The designated representative for Winfield Municipal Power Plant #2 is Warren Porter.

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process is available for public review during normal business hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at the KDHE, Bureau of Air (BOA), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366 and at the South Central District Office (SCDO), 300 West Douglas, Suite 700, Wichita, Kansas 67202-2921. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

Please direct written comments or questions regarding the proposed permit to Lynette Bayless, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received no later than noon on December 22, 2014.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permit. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Lynette Bayless, KDHE BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Ste. 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, no later than noon on December 22, 2014, in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.
