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Acronyms
NPM - National Performance Measure
<i>National Performance Measures</i> are key indicators meant to measure change (or lack of) in the risk demonstrated or assumed to be associated with health status of mothers, children and families compared to targets established based on program focus and activity.
SPM - State Performance Measure
<i>State Performance Measures</i> are key indicators meant to measure change (or lack of) in the risk demonstrated or assumed to be associated with health status of mothers, children and families compared to targets established based on program focus and activity.
NOM - National Outcome Measure
<i>National Outcome Measures</i> are key indicators meant to measure change (or lack of) in the health status of mothers, children and families.
HSCI - Health System Capacity Indicator;
<i>Health System Capacity Indicators</i> are key indicators meant to be used as a state self-assessment tool to determine how well the structures, relationships, resources, and workforce are working to improve the health of mothers, children and families.
HSI - Health Status Indicator
<i>Health Status Indicators</i> are key indicators meant to measure change (or lack of) in the risk demonstrated or assumed to be associated with health status of mothers, children and families.
