

This summit is designed to provide an overview of the accreditation process for local health departments including helpful resources, tips for gathering materials to support documentation, and lessons learned from local health departments that have applied for accreditation. After the summit, participants will have the opportunity to join an active learning group with representatives from health departments across the state who will work together on accreditation, domain by domain, and receive free technical assistance (including coaching) and other resources.

- Determine readiness to apply
- Identify gaps in documentation, required activities or practices
- Understand the PHAB requirements at a detailed level
