

## Healthy Family Services

### Program Purpose

The KDHE Bureau of Family Health receives targeted funding from the Kansas legislature to provide comprehensive services to low-income and high-risk families in Geary and Wyandotte counties utilizing a public health intensive nursing case management model. These two counties were identified due to their disparate populations and high infant mortality rates.

### Funding

Applications for funding to support Healthy Family Services should be submitted for continuation of current contracts only. Award amounts are contingent upon on State General funding available and allocated for this initiative. The proposed budget should be based on the actual amount of the award provided the previous year. At this time, a local match is not required for the Healthy Family Services grant. Grantees are expected to use these state funds as matching dollars to draw down Medicaid dollars and provide services to Medicaid-enrolled women and children in their county.

### Reporting Requirements

All grantees must submit quarterly Certified Affidavit of Expenditures. Refer to the Fiscal Reporting Section for details. A mid-year report covering the first six months (July 1 through December 31) of the contract period is due on or before January 15. The end-of-year report covering the last six months (January 1 through June 30) of the contract period is due on or before July 15.
