

## Pregnancy Maintenance Initiative (PMI)

### Project Goals

The goal of the program is to award grants to not-for-profit organizations for services to enable pregnant women to carry their pregnancies to term.

### Funding

Priority is given to continue funding of local agencies that consistently meet contract objectives, reporting requirements and participate in yearly education updates. Grants are subject to availability of funds.

- A. Match: A required match of one dollar for each State dollar awarded.
- B. Local PMI Services: Applicants should adhere to utilization of funding as described in the [Pregnancy Maintenance Initiative Manual](#).

### Specific Program Information

- A. Application – Follow the KDHE “SFY2015 Grant Application Guidance” instructions. The application budget must include expenses for staff to attend education updates.

- C. SFY 2015 Outcome Objective:
  - 1. The PMI services will provide comprehensive pregnancy support based on practices that are evidence-based/evidence-informed
  - 2. The community will be aware of the services
  - 3. The process for community involvement
  - 4. Integration with adoption services
  - 5. Method for recruiting, selecting and training case managers
  - 6. Method for recruiting participants
  - 7. Linkages with community education programs
- D. Other:
  - (1) The grantee will provide for orientation and training of new staff. Grantee staff will participate in the yearly PMI updates.
  - (2) Technical assistance will be provided via phone and/or KDHE staff may conduct on site visits. A corrective action plan for issues identified during site visits will be established and implemented as indicated.
