Course Description

Early Detection Works (EDW) is transitioning to a cloud based entry system of provider payments. No more forms! The training on the new system will include: searching for participants and enrollment status (Scheduling Training); entering payment requests for services (Payment Reimbursement Training); and looking up historical payments in the system (Payment Status Training).

Objectives:

At the conclusion of the program, participants should be able to:

- Use the new EDW data system to search for a participant and identify key enrollment information
- Understand how to enter payment requests online
- Identify EDW payable services and associated guidelines
- Search for historical payments and review the status of payment requests

To Register

Registration is required a minimum of 3 business days prior to each session. Registration is available through KS-TRAIN at www.ks.train.org. "KDHE: Early Detection Works Provider Scheduling, Payment Request, and Accounts Receivable Training (LIVE)" (course 1057357).

Providers must have completed the "KDHE: Early Detection Works Provider Overview Training" prior to attending the data entry training. If you were not able to participate in the overview training held earlier this year you will be able to view the recording posted on KS-TRAIN (course 1056215).
