

28-1-7. Isolation of food handlers with infectious or contagious diseases.

Persons employed in the preparation of food for sale or for public consumption shall be excluded from their occupations until all requirements for release from isolation of the specific infectious or contagious disease with which they are afflicted, as specified in K.A.R. 28-1-6, have been met.
