

# HealthQuest 2017 Incentive Guide

From January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 employees and spouses enrolled in medical **plan A** of the State Employee Health Plan (SEHP) have the opportunity to earn credits by participating in various well-being activities offered through HealthQuest. Those who complete the **REQUIRED** Health Assessment (worth 10 credits) and earn a total 40 credits will receive a premium incentive reduction in 2018.

Employee and Employee/Children Coverage will earn a \$480 reduction for 2018 and Employee/Spouse and Employee/Family - both the Employee and Spouse can earn a \$240 reduction (\$480 total) for 2018.
