Open enrollment will be October 1, 2014 – October 31, 2014

You can sign up for your benefits during this time. You can't sign up for benefits after October 31 unless you are a new hire or you have a qualifying life event.

Happy with your current benefits or not enrolling?

If you don't want to make any changes to your current benefit selections, you don't have to take any action. We'll re-enroll you in the same benefits you have now. We call this "passive enrollment." *Note: Plan B will not be offered in 2015. If you are currently enrolled in Plan B and don't take any action, you will be enrolled in Plan C.*


Find doctors who meet your preferences
