- The highest number of these deaths occurred among those ages 45 – 54 years old (n=149).

- Of these deaths, approximately 84% (n=113) and 16% (n=22) occurred among males and females respectively.
- The highest number of these deaths occurred among those ages 25-34 years (n=28) and those 45 – 54 years old (n=28).

- The highest number of these deaths occurred among those ages 25-34 years old (n=15).

- The highest number of these deaths occurred among those ages 15-24 years (n=51) and those ages 45 – 54 years (n=51).
