Data loggers collect vaccine storage unit temperature data 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Data loggers allows for improved temperature accountability and will assist in decreasing the amount of wasted VFC vaccine due to unknown storage unit temperatures. Sensitech Temptale[®]4 dataloggers, supplied by KIP will provide a temperature recording history every 10 minutes during the download period. Temperature excursion alarms are visible on the LCD digital reading with an “X”. Data logger history data can only be viewed after the data has been electronically downloaded and viewed on the Sensitech Cold Stream portal. The data download will be used to determine the efficacy of the vaccine inventory and the ability of the storage units to store vaccine safely.

Providers must document temperatures of each vaccine storage units twice daily. This documentation will ensue that the temperatures were evaluated at the time documented and by the staff responsible.

This Provider User Agreement describes the terms and conditions for use of the program supplied data logger.

KIP shall:

1. Provide a maximum of two (2) TempTale[®]4 USB Multi-Alarm Monitors (data loggers) per calibration period. Calibration period is typically for one year from the date of shipment. This date is found on the calibration certificate and the back of each monitor.
2. Provide initial scheduled training via webinar conducted by Sensitech on the use of the data logger.
3. Provide with ongoing education and use of the data loggers.
4. Assist with temperature excursion recommendations.

Provider shall:

1. Schedule a training on the Sensitech Portal Training calendar.
2. Install datalogger software, complete initial training and use data loggers as directed by Sensitech and KIP
3. Use KIP supplied datalogger as the **primary** certified calibrated thermometer. Not to be used as backup thermometer.
4. Keep datalogger certificate of calibration in clinic file.
5. Document vaccine storage unit’s temperature reading twice daily with time of day and name of person on a paper temperature logs. Temperature logs are to be kept in clinic file for three (3) years.

6. Datalogger temperature data must be downloaded prior to placing a vaccine order.
7. Datalogger must be downloaded immediately when the alarm icon is displayed with an “X” on the LCD. Quarantine vaccine until out of range temperatures are evaluated.
8. Note that by not monitoring datalogger temperatures the provider will be subject to corrective action or disenrollment.
9. Maintain data loggers in a manner to prevent damage, theft or destruction.
10. Replace damaged, destroyed, or stolen data loggers at a cost of \$100.00 each.
11. Notify KIP if provider terminates the use of the datalogger.
