## Are ANY of the following conditions present?

- The work is a lead abatement project.
- Work is disturbing 6 square feet or less interior or 20 square feet or less exterior and does not include window replacement/repair, demolition or prohibited practices. Prohibited practices are:
  - Open-flame burning or torching
  - Use of machines that remove coatings through high speed operation such as sanding, grinding, power planing, needle gun, abrasive blasting, or sandblasting, unless such machines have containment systems or shrouds equipped with a HEPA vacuum attachment to collect dust and debris.
  - Operating a heat gun.
- The property has been determined to be lead-based paint free by a KDHE licensed Risk Assessor or Lead Inspector and a copy of the inspection report has been received.
- Property is a zero-bedroom dwelling such as studio apartments, dormitories, military barracks, etc.
- Housing is for the elderly or disabled and no children under six reside or are expected to reside there. (Meaning retirement or similar types of housing specifically reserved for households of one or more persons 62 years of age or older.

EPA lead-based paint renovation, repair, and painting program requirements do not apply.

## Is the project an emergency renovation?

Emergency renovations are unplanned renovation activities performed in response to a sudden, unexpected event that, if not immediately attended to, presents a safety or public health hazard or threatens property with significant damage. Emergency renovation operations shall include renovations to repair damage from a tree that fell on a house and renovations to repair a water pipe break in an apartment complex.

Pre-renovation education requirements do not apply and are exempt from posting warning signs, containment, waste handling, training and certification requirements to the extent necessary to respond to the emergency. Cleaning and cleaning verification requirements must still be followed.
