



Screening should be completed within 24-48 hours of birth

Screenings should be completed on right hand AND foot

Positive Screen = Failed Screen :

~ The O2 sat is <90% in either extremity during any of the screenings

~ The O2 sat is <95% for all three screens that are performed at least one hour apart

~ The difference between the right upper extremity and the foot $\geq 3\%$



Negative Screen = Pass Screen

~ O2 Sat $\geq 95\%$

~ The difference between the right upper extremity and foot is $\leq 3\%$

*Infants in special care nurseries (including intermediate care and neonatal intensive care, etc.) should be screened at 24-48 hours of age or when medically appropriate after 24 hours of age. In all cases, screening should occur prior to discharge from the hospital.
