**EMERGENCY ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

NOW on this 5 day of November, 2015, Susan Mosier, MD, Secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment [Secretary], reviews the file on the group day care home operated by LoRene Wille [Licensee].

WHEREUPON, the Secretary finds that:

1. The Kansas Department of Health and Environment [KDHE] issued to Licensee, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-501 *et seq.*, a renewed license to operate a group day care home, effective January 1, 2015.

2. On or about November 3, 2015, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment conducted a survey of Licensee's group day care home. Licensee was caring for three children, three months of age, twenty months of age and a three year old. Licensee allowed the three month old infant to nap in a car seat and the four year old to nap on the couch. Licensee had difficulty physically moving the three month old infant into and out of a playpen used for napping. After the infant awoke in the playpen the infant was left in the playpen and Licensee did not remove the child or attend to the infant's needs. Licensee indicated that if necessary she

would have to take one child at a time to an area of safety in the case of an emergency such as a fire. Cleaning supplies were accessible to children and a lawn mower was accessible in the play area. Children were not offered a choice of activities or toys or equipment to play with in the home. Licensee also did not have a current first aid and CPR certificate on file.

3. K.S.A. 65-524 authorizes the Secretary to suspend a license to operate a group day care home prior to a hearing when, in the opinion of the Secretary, said suspension is necessary to protect any child in the home from physical or mental abuse, abandonment, or any other substantial threat to health or safety.

4. Due to the facts contained in paragraph 2 above, the Secretary has determined that immediate suspension of Licensee's license is necessary to protect children in Licensee's care from a substantial threat to their health or safety.

5. Licensee is hereby required, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-506, to notify the parents and guardians of the children in care in writing that her license has been suspended.

WHEREUPON, the Secretary hereby suspends Licensee's license to operate a group day care home, effective immediately, thereby prohibiting Licensee from caring for children. This Emergency Order of Suspension remains in effect until the issuance of an order rescinding this order.

### **RIGHT TO A HEARING**

This Emergency Order of Suspension is issued pursuant to K.S.A. 77-536 of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.

Licensee may file a Petition for Reconsideration by filing such petition with Secretary Susan Mosier, MD, Secretary, Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Curtis State Office Bldg., Ste. 540, 1000 SW Jackson, Topeka, Kansas 66612. The Petition for Reconsideration shall be filed within 15 days of the service of the Emergency Order of Suspension. The filing of a petition is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative review.

Licensee may file a Petition for Judicial Review pursuant to K.S.A. 77-610. A Petition for Judicial Review shall be filed within 30 days after service of the Emergency Order of Suspension or 30 days after an Order Denying a Request for Reconsideration. Service of the Petition for Judicial Review shall be served on Secretary Susan Mosier, MD, Secretary, Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Curtis State Office Bldg., Ste. 540, 1000 SW Jackson, Topeka, Kansas 66612.
