The session will cover groundwater remediation efforts

TOPEKA, Kan. -- The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) announces a public availability session scheduled for 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 17 at the Haysville High School located at 106 Stewart Avenue, Haysville, Kansas.

The KDHE Dry Cleaner Remediation Program will be available at 6:00 p.m. to discuss contamination attributed to the Former American Cleaners site at 412 West Grand Avenue. KDHE will provide information regarding the current impacts the contamination has on domestic wells; plans to provide short- and long-term alternative drinking water supplies to impacted areas; and long-term remediation needs.
