<p>This month we don't have a question from a clinic. Here is a reminder from the State Agency staff about the use of "Other" for proofs in KWIC.</p>	<p>If you choose "Other" for any proofs in KWIC, you need to document what you accepted as proof.</p> <p>For residency and identity, use the "regular" notes window. For income, there is a note field on the income window. If you write something in the note field on the income window, your note is automatically copied in the "regular" notes with a title "Income Eligibility Determination". (See February 2009 KWIC Focus.)</p> <p>There is a bug that does not allow an income note if the client is over income. Until that bug is fixed, use the "regular" notes if you need to make an income note for a client who is over income.</p>
