"We have two primary shared populations with the health department including pregnant women and people diagnosed with HIV. We also have had shared grants and currently share a grant from the Wyandotte Health Foundation funding radiology needs for patients. Our work with the local hospital has been close for many years and include our joint prenatal project — Maternal Options that Matter."

ADDRESSING COMMUNITY HEALTH  
PRIORITIES

"We are closely monitoring and aggressively treating our adult diabetes patients by 1) continuing to schedule regular visits with our adult diabetes patients, and moving toward increasing the frequency of appointment reminder calls to ensure patients return for care, 2) checking their HbA1c blood levels, 3) monitoring and treating any hypertension, 4) monitoring and treating any other medical complications related to diabetes."

"Family Health Care meets most of the criteria for a patient-centered medical home (Score 10/12) but we have not applied for recognition due partly to prohibitive cost"

USING GRANT FUNDS TO IMPROVE  
PATIENT CARE

"Our goal is to provide full-service health care for a medically indigent population including wrap-around services such as dental, mental health and social services. We have a secondary goal of moving forward to transition in the next two to three years to an FQHC. The funds requested will enable us to continue at the current level of services."
