Kansas Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Act

28-68-6. Deductible payment. On initiation of corrective action by the department at a contaminated ~~drycleaning~~ dry-cleaning site, the applicant shall pay to the department the applicable deductible, minus the reasonable, direct costs incurred by the applicant to collect the application information as ~~set forth~~ specified in K.A.R. 28-68-5, ~~subsection (f)~~. The deductible shall be ~~\$2,500.00~~ \$5,000.00 for each ~~drycleaning~~ dry-cleaning facility ~~which that~~ has contributed to the contamination of the contaminated ~~drycleaning~~ dry-cleaning site. Under the conditions ~~set forth~~ specified in K.S.A. ~~1995 Supp.~~ 65-34,148, ~~subsection (g)~~ and amendments thereto, the owner of any property that includes an existing or former a ~~drycleaning~~ dry-cleaning facility may be responsible for up to 100% of the costs of corrective action attributable to the owner.
