QSA Global Certificate of Compliance
expiration

Addressees

Industrial Radiography licensees

Purpose

This information notice will serve notice to the affected licensees of the actions the Kansas Department of Health and Environment expects as a result of the 660 Series Projector Type B Certificate Expiration.

Description of Circumstances

In August 2009, QSA Global, Inc. (QSA) notified its customers that it does not intend to renew the NRC Certificate of Compliance No. USA/9283/B(U)-96, for the 660 Series radiographic projector. Therefore, when the Certificate of Compliance expires at the end of June 2013, the 660 Series devices may no longer be transported by licensees or by commercial carriers.
