Field Activities

Pre-Design Data Acquisition efforts were conducted, consisting of:

- A site-wide water level measurement round on July 17, 2014 with 219 total well elevations and 13 surface water elevations collected;
- Groundwater samples collected from 76 deep and 83 shallow wells at a total of 104 locations during the 3rd quarter; and,
- Direct push groundwater samples collected from 74 deep and 75 shallow sample depths at a total of 82 locations during the 3rd quarter.

Reviews and Submittals

July 2, 2014. On behalf of the City of Wichita, SCS Aquaterra revises the RD/PDA Work Plan and submits to KDHE.

July 23, 2014. City provides KDHE with responses to KDHE's June 5, 2014 comment letter and a detailed schedule for the NIC Project.

July 29, 2014. KDHE issued Approval Letter for the NIC Final Remedial Design/Pre-Design Data Acquisition (RD/PDA) Work Plan etc.

Submit PDA data report to KDHE in January 2015

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
