Division Budget

- FY2016 budget totals \$65,118,225
- Funding sources:
 - State General Fund \$4.3 million 7.4%
 - State Water Plan \$1.7 million 2.9%
 - Fee Funds \$17.2 million 28.9%
 - Federal Funds \$17.2 million 29.1%
 - Agency and Trusts \$18.8 million 31.7%

 - Indirects and Transfers \$5.8 million

2015 Legislation

- Very successful legislative session
- DOE carried 7 bills (3 remediation, 2 waste, 2 water)
- Also much focus on EPA's Clean Power Plan proposal and its anticipated impact on Kansas

- 2016 Legislative agenda for DOE not set



Challenges

- State funding picture has stabilized in comparison to recent years
- Staffing – the greatest challenge is and will continue to be filling vacancies and facing high level of retirements over the next several years

 - Contaminated sites: Currently or historically contaminated by a spill, release, discharge or waste placement.

- Quickly identify environmental interests
 - *Not included: Public Water Supply and Confined Animal Feeding Operations*
- Basic information is available on-line for free – No KORA costs!!!!
- Provide site specific names and program ID#s to assist with KORA requests, which lowers KORA costs
- Links to several program/site-specific web pages for more information
- Export data to a spreadsheet and print map to pdf
