

HIV/AIDS Surveillance Definitions

HIV (non AIDS) cases: Individuals infected with HIV, but have not yet progressed to AIDS

AIDS Cases: Individuals infected with HIV and whose CD4 counts are <200 or CD4 cells $<14\%$ of total T lymphocytes or present or previous AIDS defining opportunistic infections.

HIV/AIDS Cases: Individuals who either meet HIV (non AIDS) cases definition or AIDS case definition.

HIV Infection Cases: Regardless of AIDS status, individuals infected with HIV virus

HIV Disease Cases: Individuals who either meet HIV (non AIDS) cases definition or AIDS case definition.

Incident HIV Cases: Number of new HIV (non AIDS) cases during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 2006 – December 31st 2006).

Prevalent HIV Cases: Number of living cases of HIV (non AIDS) during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 1983 – December 31st 2006).

Cumulative HIV Cases: Total number of HIV cases (non AIDS), including both living and dead during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 1983 – December 31st 2006).

Incident AIDS Cases: Number of new AIDS cases during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 2006 – December 31st 2006).

Prevalent AIDS Cases: Number of living cases of AIDS during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 1983 – December 31st 2006).

Cumulative AIDS Cases: Total number of AIDS cases including both living and dead during specific time period (E.g. January 1st 1983 – December 31st 2006).

Date of Diagnosis: Date when a case was diagnosed.

Date of Report: Date when a case was reported to the HIV/AIDS Surveillance Program.
