To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of Koch Nitrogen Company (KNC), this letter transmits a Closure Plan for the Dodge City Nitrogen Plant Chromium Destruct Unit (CDU). This Closure Plan was prepared and is submitted in accordance with Section III.B.1 of Part I of Permit No. KSD044625010.

KNC purchased the facility that is subject to the above referenced permit on May 20, 2003, and the permit was transferred to KNC effective on the date of purchase. The permit requires the submittal of certain data that were collected prior to this purchase and prior to the effective date of the permit. KNC has access to information collected by the former owner that appears responsive to the submittal requirement; however, KNC cannot make any representations as to the truth, accuracy, or completeness of this information because KNC was not the facility owner at the time the information was collected and does not know what quality assurance or quality control systems were employed by the prior owner. In order to provide you with whatever information is available to us, KNC is submitting this closure plan but is not able to represent or certify to the truth, accuracy, or completeness of the historical information included in the plan.


