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Subject: Additional documentation for EI purposes

Katrina:

On of the issues to attaining the Environmental Indicator (EI) 725-Human Health Exposures Under Control was the Community College farming on the Facility property.

I have a letter from Brian Moore dated April 8, 2004, that states the Facility allowed the College to farm in a SWMU (East Pond), but that "...KNC believes that it should take the conservative step of ensuring that crops are not harvested from this area until such time as monitoring data can demonstrate that there would be no risks presented by farming activity. Consequently, KNC has reached verbal agreement with DCCC that crops currently growing on that portion of the land will not be harvested, and that the parties will amend the current lease to remove that portion of the land from the lease."

The above states, "...verbal agreement with DCCC..." I need a letter from KNC documenting that the lease has been amended to remove that area from farming and that the crops currently growing on that portion of the land have not and will not be harvested! EPA wants to make sure that no one is being exposed to contamination, and to do that I need written documentation of that fact.

Additionally, is KNC purchasing bottled water for the Coker's and Bogner's? I know the Bogners have been purchasing their own bottled water since approximately 2001. Did KNC take over the purchase of the bottled water for the Bogners and if so, when did that occur? Is KNC also paying for the Cokers bottled water and if so, when did that occur? Please provide a status report on getting the Cokers and Bogners hooked up to City water?

I have a letter dated November 24, 2003, from Stephen B. Ellingson, that states, "KNC would like to emphasize that both the Cokers and Bogners ar using bottled water as a source of drinking water. Therefore, neither the Cokers nor the Bogners are drinking groundwater adjacent to the Plant."

In that letter regarding documentation of the farming activities, you could also include the information on the Chaffin well, as well as the update on the Cokers and Bogners, and the above questions regarding their bottled water use.
