On September 1, 2004, Koch Nitrogen Company (KNC) submitted the Semi-Annual Groundwater Corrective Action Report for the Dodge City Nitrogen Plant. As a follow-up to that submission, representatives from KNC, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) met on September 16, 2004. KNC would like to thank you and the other KDHE and USEPA representatives for the time on September 16, 2004. One objective of this very productive meeting was to discuss the supplemental information submitted by KNC.

During the meeting we discussed the permit issues and clarifications contained in the supplemental information. KDHE suggested, and KNC agrees, that many of these issues and clarifications could be resolved by amending Part I of the Hazardous Waste Management Facility Permit and the Part B Permit Application, which contains the Sampling and Analysis Plan. The Part I Permit and Part B Permit Application are undergoing a Class 1 Modification. KNC will provide to KDHE proposed text to amend these documents as soon as possible.

As the new Environmental Compliance Manager for the Dodge City Nitrogen Plant, I appreciated the opportunity to meet you and the other KDHE and USEPA staff working on this project.
