Andrea and Everett,

We agree with Andrea that more frequent, informal communication would be helpful.

As to activities that are ongoing, KNC is planning to resume soil sampling in April or May, after the 2nd quarter groundwater sampling is completed.

Currently, the activity around the RO Equalization basin is the continuing investigation on whether the December 2009 repairs to the basin liner fixed the source(s) of the leak. While the outer wall crack has remained dry since the seepage on November 30, 2009, there is evidence of water in the interstitial space between the liner and the wall in the leak detection tubes. We have been monitoring the water level in the tubes and over the next couple of weeks plan to pump the water from the tubes. This will help to verify whether the water in the tubes is water from a new leak in the liner or from the fabric that was saturated by the initial leak on November 30, 2009.

We don't consider these update emails a formal report, so we are assuming that the signature requirements in the RCRA permit (Part 1, Section 1.F, and Part 2, Section B.22) do not apply.

I look forward to sharing our progress in these update emails.
