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

**Re: Temporary Authorization – Recovery Well Shut-Down
Koch Nitrogen Company, Dodge City

Dear Mr. Sherbak:

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) reviewed Koch Nitrogen Company's (KNC) letter dated September 14, 2012 requesting temporary authorization to cease operation of the groundwater recovery system to perform maintenance and clean portions of the wastewater system. KDHE is approving this request in accordance with 40 CFR 270.42(e). The duration of this authorization will be limited to 10 calendar days from the initiation of the proposed activities.

In accordance with 40 CFR 270.42(e), this temporary authorization request requires the permittee to send a notice of the request to all persons on the facility mailing list within 7 calendar days of submission. The notice must specify the temporary changes being implemented and explain why they are necessary. If you have not completed this requirement already, please do so at this time. A copy of the mailing list is enclosed to assist in completing this task. Also, to help keep addresses current, include the following text in your mailing list notification:

In accordance with 40 CFR 124.10 and 40 CFR 270.42, this notice has been sent to all persons on the facility mailing list, which is maintained by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Bureau of Waste Management. Any recipient of this notice that wishes to be removed from the facility mailing list or would like to have future notices sent to a different location should notify KDHE, in writing, at the address below. KDHE attempts to maintain current addresses; however, if this notice is returned to KDHE as undeliverable, the intended recipient and address will be removed from the mailing list after a reasonable attempt to find a correct address for the intended recipient.

Should KNC receive requests in response to this text, forward them to me for consideration.

During this temporary authorization period, KNC is required to meet all applicable permit conditions and any other applicable state, federal, and/or local requirements.
