

# **Mailing List Notification**

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is announcing its intent to renew a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit to Koch Nitrogen Company, LLC (owner/operator) located at 11559 U.S. Highway 50; Dodge City, Kansas. The permit will require the facility to conduct Closure and Post-Closure Care of the Chromium Destruct Unit as well as groundwater monitoring and corrective action. The permit includes provisions for corrective action for all Solid Waste Management Units and Areas of Concern.

The Draft Permit, Part A and Part B Permit Applications, Administrative Record, and Fact Sheet are available for public review from September 2, 2014 through October 17, 2014 during normal business hours at the KDHE office at 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 320, Topeka, Kansas, and the Dodge City Public Library at 1001 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Dodge City, Kansas. A public hearing has not been scheduled; however, if written requests are received indicating significant degree of public interest in the draft permit, a public hearing will be scheduled. More information on this permit renewal action may be obtained from Mr. Mostafa Kamal of KDHE at (785) 296-1609. Written comments related to this permit renewal action must be received by KDHE postmarked no later than October 17, 2014.

After consideration of all comments received, the Secretary of KDHE will make a final decision on the permit. Notice will be given to the applicant, those who submitted written comments, and those who requested to be included in the mailing list of the final permit decision. If none of the comments received during the public comment period result in revision(s) to the draft permit, the permit will become effective immediately upon its issuance. If comments received during the public comment period result in revision(s), the permit will become effective thirty (30) days after service of notice of the final decision to allow for public review of the revisions. Appeals of the final permit decision for must be filed within 15 days after service of notice in accordance with K.S.A. 65-3440 and K.S.A. 77-601 et.seq.

In accordance with 40 CFR 124.10 and 40 CFR 270.42, this notice has been sent to all persons on the facility mailing list, which is maintained by The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Bureau of Waste Management. Any recipient of this notice that wishes to be removed from the facility mailing list or would like to have future notices sent to a different location should notify KDHE, in writing, at the address below. KDHE attempts to maintain current addresses; however, if this notice is returned to KDHE as undeliverable, the intended recipient and address will be removed from the mailing list after a reasonable attempt to find a correct address for the intended recipient.
