PUBLIC NOTICE

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has reviewed an application from Resource Management Company, Inc. to establish and operate a waste tire processing facility. Resource Management Company, Inc. is expanding to this new facility to have an all weather location and serve a proposed customer at the same location. Tires will be brought in by company owned trucks to be sorted for resale or disposal. Tires that are not resalable will either have the sidewall cut out for feed bunks and tarp weights or the tires will be ground to the customer's specification or to a minimum size for disposal in the company owned landfill.

This facility is located in the SE ¼, Section 34, Township 19 S, Range 14 W, Barton County, at Westport Addition, 9071 8th St., Bldg L, Great Bend, Kansas. KDHE has reviewed the application and found it to be in conformance with the state waste tire statutes and regulations.

KDHE is today providing public notice of their intent to issue a permit to Resource Management Company, Inc. for the proposed waste tire processing facility described herein.
