- Daily Cover Lacking
- Litter Onsite/Offsite
- Failure to Document
 - Random Load Inspections
 - Quarterly Gas Monitoring
 - Copy of Current Facility Permit
- Inadequate Training
 - Know Your Operation Plan

Daily Cover


- How many inches of soil is required?
- Alternative Daily Cover (ADC)
 - Must Prevent Blowing Litter
 - Must minimize vector access
 - Must minimize fire threat
 - Must minimize odors
 - Must assist in shedding precipitation
