NOTICE OF HEARING

FOR JENNIFER GERETY - BANCROFT SITE

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has prepared a proposed Kansas Water Pollution Control Permit, A-KSNM-S044 for Jennifer Gerety – Bancroft Site, located in Bancroft, Kansas.

This is a new permit for the operation and construction of a confined feeding facility for 2,490 head (996 animal units) of swine weighing greater than 55 pounds. The proposed facility would consist of two enclosed confinement buildings and two self-contained concrete pits. The facility would be located in the North Half of the South Half of Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 14 East in Nemaha County, Kansas. A notice in the Kansas Register dated May 17, 2018, informed the public of the availability of the proposed water pollution control permit for Jennifer Gerety – Bancroft Site. A public hearing has been scheduled in conformance with Kansas Administrative Regulation 28-16-61.

A public hearing on the proposed permit has been scheduled at 5:30 pm Central Standard Time, Tuesday, August 14, 2018, at the Goff Community Center, 1723 State Highway 9, Goff, Kansas 66428.
