OUTSTANDING NATIONAL RESOURCE WATERS

The following surface waters in the state of Kansas are identified as Outstanding National Resource Waters (ONRW) pursuant to the Kansas Surface Water Register dated June 1, 1999. The ONRW classification applies to all waters contained within the particular Wildlife and Park, Wildlife Refuge, State Park, wetland, or Wildlife Area. Direct discharges to these waters will not be allowed. Discharges to tributaries of these waters will be reviewed to determine that the discharge will not cause a degradation of the waters in these areas.
