Renewal dates to child care facility licenses were extended under previous executive orders issued by the Governor. Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 21-22 issued on April 27, 2021 (<https://governor.kansas.gov/wp-content/uploads/2021/04/EO-21-22-Prof-Licenses-Discretionary-Executed.pdf>), the agency/program may begin to require renewals with a published 15-day notification.

The KDHE Child Care Licensing Program facility license renewals are no longer waived, and all outstanding renewals are due within 30 days of this notice. Outstanding child care renewal applications (including those that did not renew in 2020) are due by June 16, 2021.
