The KDHE is committed to conducting public hearings in a manner that is fair, transparent, and efficient. Due to federal, state, and local guidelines regarding social distancing and crowd size in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, public hearings conducted by KDHE/Bureau of Environmental Field Services/Livestock Waste Management will be conducted virtually via Zoom.

Immediately upon registering for a hearing from the link provided in the hearing notice you should receive an email at the address used on the registration form that your registration was approved. You can add this hearing to your calendar by clicking the "Add to calendar" link within the registration approval. This works for Google Calendar, Outlook Calendar (.ics) and Yahoo Calendar. The emailed link will allow you to observe and listen to the virtual meeting as an attendee.

At the end of the hearing presentation there will be time for attendees to provide oral comments. If you indicated on the registration form you wish to provide comment, your name will be called. You will be unmuted and allowed three (3) minutes to provide comments.
