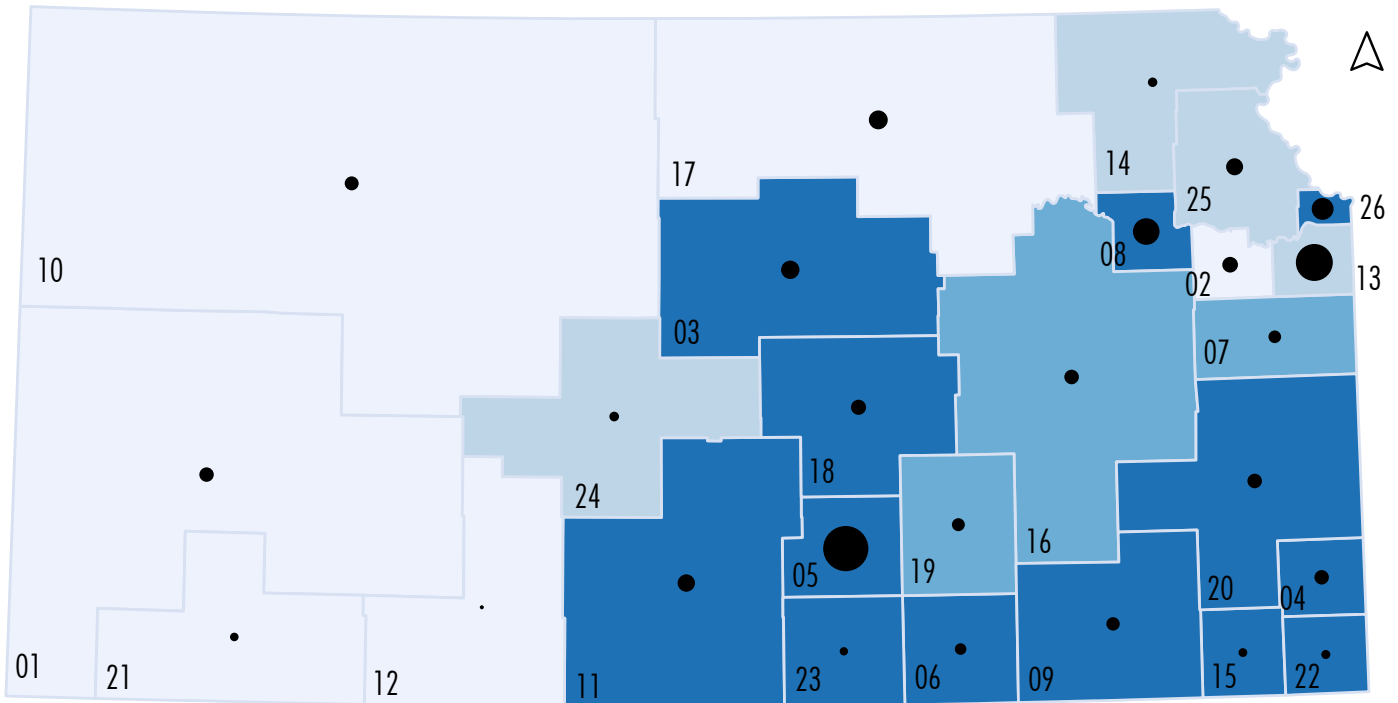


Suicide Hospital Discharges (HD) 2004 - 2013
