Dental Services

Local health department providers must obtain a dental provider number from KMAP to be reimbursed for dental services. All dental services for Title 19 and Title 21 beneficiaries should be filed on an ADA dental claim form (version date 2000 or later) using the KMAP dental provider number and submitted to EDS. Dental services should not be filed to either of the managed care organizations for Title 21 beneficiaries. Dental service claims should be submitted to EDS for **ALL** KMAP beneficiaries. Non-physician (i.e.: dentist or LHD) provider applications are available on the KMAP Web site.
