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## **KANSAS TEENAGE PREGNANCY REPORT**

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) annually publishes a teenage pregnancy report, summarizing data collected from vital records on fetal deaths, abortions, and live births. The total of these three elements represents the number of pregnancies. KDHE has compiled nine tables containing pregnancy totals and pregnancy rates for the following age-groups 10-17, 15-17, 10-14, and 15-19 by county of residence.

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## Technical Notes

Abortion (induced termination of pregnancy): The purposeful interruption of pregnancy with the intention other than to produce a live-born infant or to remove a dead fetus and which does not result in a live birth.

Fetal Death: Any complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of human conception, the weight of which is in excess of 350 grams, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, resulting in other than a live birth, and which is not an induced termination of pregnancy

Live Birth: The complete expulsion or extraction of a product of human conception from its mother, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, that, after such expulsion or extraction, shows any evidence of life such as breathing, heartbeat, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or voluntary muscle movement, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta attached.

Residence Data: Residence data is information compiled according to the usual residence regardless of where the event occurred (including events occurring out-of-state).

Teenage Pregnancy: A live birth, fetal death or abortion occurring to a female under 20 years of age.

Teenage Pregnancy Rate: 
$$\frac{\text{live births, fetal deaths, abortions for females in a specific age-group}}{\text{female population in a specific age-group}} \times 1,000$$

1997-1998 female 10-17 and 10-19 age-group county population estimates were compiled by the U.S. Census Bureau as of 7/1/97 and 7/1/98.

County estimates were then adjusted to the 1996-1998 Census totals for the state.

1999 state and county female 10-17 and 10-19 age-group population estimates were compiled by the U.S. Census Bureau as of 7/1/99 (Internet release date: 8/30/00).

1997-1999 state and county female 15-17 age-group population estimates were compiled by the U.S. Census Bureau as of July 1 of each year (Internet release date: 8/30/00).

2000 female age-group county population counts were compiled by the U.S. Census Bureau as of 4/1/2001.

2001 female age-group county population estimates were compiled by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment based on the 2000 Census counts.

### Rate Reliability:

Vital statistics are easily influenced by random variation, and single-year rates can fluctuate from year to

year. A multiple-year rate, such as a 5- or 10- year average of single-year rates, would be more accurate in formulating conclusions on vital events. For example, between 1997 and 2001, the teenage pregnancy rate for Kansas varied from 28.8 to 33.3 teenage pregnancies per 1,000 10-19 female population. The 1997-2001 5-year teenage pregnancy rate was 31.3. The 5-year rate smooths some of the variation in single-year rates and would be a more reliable indicator of teenage pregnancy rates in Kansas.

Rates based on a small or large number of events in a sparsely populated area can vary widely. To exemplify the variation that may occur with a small change in the number of events, in 2001, Comanche County had the lowest 10-19 female population in Kansas at 108 and Sedgwick County had the highest at 33,645. With 1 teenage pregnancy occurring in Comanche County in 2001, the 10-19 teenage pregnancy rate was 9.3; whereas 1,159 teenage pregnancies occurring in Sedgwick County resulted in a teen pregnancy rate of 34.4 per 1,000 10-19 female population. If 5 more teenage pregnancies had occurred in each county, Comanche County's teenage pregnancy rate would have increased to 55.6, while Sedgwick County's rate would have increased only slightly, to 34.6 teenage pregnancies per 1,000 10-19 female population. Therefore, one must use caution when comparing rates of vital events between counties of significantly different population sizes to avoid misleading conclusions.
