



State of Kansas Reported Cases of Chlamydia by Month January - June 2017









January - June 2017









State of Kansas Reported Cases of Gonorrhea by Month January - June 2017






State of Kansas Reported Cases of Gonorrhea by Race * January - June 2017



State of Kansas Reported Cases of Gonorrhea by County January - June 2017









State of Kansas Reported Cases of Early Syphilis by Month January - June 2017









January - June 2017














