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Disclaimer: There may be differences from previously reported data due to data cleaning efforts.

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Notes:

- In calendar year 2014 the STI/HIV Surveillance Program identified 97 incident cases of HIV. Of these 97 cases; 1 case was identified as having the transmission category “MSM & IDU”.

For the first half of 2015 (January – June) the STI/HIV Surveillance Program identified 45 incident cases of HIV. Of these 45 cases; 6 cases were identified as having the transmission category “MSM & IDU”.

This is an increase from 1% of incident cases identified in a twelve month period (January – December 2014), to 13% of incident cases identified in a six month period (January – June 2015) with the transmission category of “MSM & IDU”.

- Incident Cases: Individuals with HIV or AIDS who are newly reported to Kansas between January 1, 2015 – June 30, 2015.
- Prevalent Cases: Individuals with HIV or AIDS who are presumed to be alive as of June 30, 2015.

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



