NOTICE OF HEARING

FOR HENRY CREEK SOW FARM – DOUG CLAASSEN

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has prepared a proposed Kansas Water Pollution Control Permit, A-WABU-S045 for Henry Creek Sow Farm – Doug Claassen, located near Potwin, Kansas.

This is a new permit for the operation and construction of a confined feeding facility for 1,807 head (722.8 animal units) of swine weighing greater than 55 pounds and 2,200 head (220 animal units) of swine weighing less than 55 pounds. The proposed facility would consist of two enclosed confinement buildings, an animal mortality compost building, and a concrete waste storage tank. The facility would be located in the North Half of Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 4 East in Butler County, Kansas. A notice in the Kansas Register dated July 12, 2018, informed the public of the availability of the proposed water pollution control permit for Henry Creek Sow Farm – Doug Claassen. A public hearing has been scheduled in conformance with Kansas Administrative Regulation 28-16-61.

A public hearing on the proposed permit has been scheduled at 5:30 pm Central Standard Time, Tuesday, October 2, 2018, at the Potwin Community House, 201 North Miller, Potwin, Kansas.
